Subject: Re-numbering of existing UG level HSS electives in compliance of the new BTech and BDes course structure

As per BTech courses' structure applicable from 2018 batch onwards and as per BDes courses' structure applicable from 2019 batch onwards, students are to register for a HSS Elective - I (HS 1xx) and a HSS Elective - II Level-I (HS 1xx) respectively in their 4th and 5th semester of study. Similarly, a BTech student needs to register for a HSS Elective – I Level II (HS 2xx) and a HSS Elective - II Level-II (HS 2xx) in their 7th and 8th semester of studies.

However, it is to be noted that the existing HSS electives which are numbered in the format HS 2xx, HS 3xx and HS 4xx are offered to the students in 3rd.4th,5th and 8th semester of their studies as per the BTech course structure applicable up to 2017 batch and as per the BDes course structure applicable up to 2018 batch.

Department of HSS has provided a list of existing BTech/BDes level HSS electives by grouping it into HSS Level I and HSS Level II in compliance to the new course structure applicable for BTech and BDes students and is placed at <u>Annexure I</u> along with the new course numbers which will be applicable for BTech students of 2018 batch and onwards and for BDes students of 2019 batch onwards.

For 2017 batch of BTech students we need to retain the existing BTech HS 4xx level electives to offer in the 8th semester of study and HS 3xx level UG electives to offer in the 5th semester of study for 2018 batch BDes students in parallel.
