5. Application Process

1. Applications for PhD/MTech/MDes/MS(R)/MA programmes should be submitted only online through the Application Portal : https://www.iitg.ac.in/admission
2. Applications will not be accepted in any other mode.
3. Before submission of applications, please go through the information provided on this admission website carefully.
4. Candidates need to register only once on the Application Portal. Under the same login, candidates can submit applications to multiple programmes and disciplines. But, application fee should be paid separately for each application.

5.	Submission of online application is a three step process. Unless all the three steps are completed, the application will not be treated as complete. Incomplete applications will not be considered for processing. <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Step-1: Personal information including the educational qualifications. • Step-2: Selection of programme. • Step-3: Online payment of application fee.
6.	For submission of applications to different programmes and disciplines, the candidates have to repeat step-2 and step-3.
7.	Application & Processing Fee: In step-3 of the online application process, each candidate needs to make payment of application (processing) fee online as per the following: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • All Female Candidates: Rs.300/- • All Transgender Candidates: Rs.300/- • All SC/ ST/ PwD Candidates: Rs.300/- • All Other Candidates: Rs.600/-
8.	Applications without successful (online) payment of application fee shall be rejected.

6. Selection Process

1.	Applications of the candidates which are complete in all respects are considered valid.
2.	For each programme, the respective academic division (department/school/centre) will process the valid applications discipline wise and/or specialization wise.
3.	MEC: The applicants who do not satisfy the minimum eligibility criteria and norms will not be considered for shortlisting/selection process.
4.	Shortlisting: The Institute reserves the right to consider a limited number of eligible candidates for selection process by setting additional shortlisting criteria based on the performance in GATE/NET/CEED, grades/marks in the qualifying degree examination and/or other educational qualifications starting from Class 10.
5.	The shortlisted candidates shall be considered for the selection process.
6.	Selections for MA/MDes/MS(R)/PhD programmes shall be based on the performance of candidates in the previous educational qualifications and in the written test and/or interview conducted by the respective academic division.
7.	<p>i) COAP: Regular category seats for GATE qualified candidates in the following disciplines of MTech programme shall be offered through COAP 2025, organized by IISc, Bengaluru (https://gate.iisc.ac.in/coap2025/):</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> Biotechnology Bioengineering Civil Engineering Computer Science and Engineering Chemical Engineering Electronics and Electrical Engineering Mechanical Engineering Data Science Robotics and Artificial Intelligence Biomedical Science and Engineering <p>Such applicants have to follow the COAP schedule for accepting the offered seats. Selection of such applicants will be, typically, based on only GATE score. However, for certain disciplines/specializations, the academic division may also decide to conduct written test and/or interview (which will carry a maximum of 30% weightage).</p> <p>ii) Selections for other categories (regular with IIT Degree, and non-regular) for the MTech programmes listed above (in point (i)), and for all categories for all other MTech programmes shall be based on the performance of candidates in the previous educational qualifications and in the written test and/or interview conducted by the respective academic division.</p>
8.	<p>Mode of Selection: The selection for a particular programme and discipline will be conducted in one of the following modes, as decided by the respective academic division:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Offline: All stages of the selection process shall be completely offline for which the candidates have to come to the campus and participate in the selection process. • Online: All stages of the selection process shall be completely online through video conferencing through MS Teams, G-Meet, etc., as per the convenience. For no stage of the selection the candidates need to come to the campus.

- **Hybrid:** Some stages of the selection process shall be Online and some stages of the selection process shall be Offline. At every stage, selection process shall be either Online or Offline for ALL the candidates shortlisted for that stage. That is, in a particular stage, it is not permitted to conduct the selection Online for one candidate and Offline for another candidate.
 - An example for hybrid mode: In stage-1, all shortlisted candidates shall face screening interviews online. Then, in stage-2, all those candidates who are further shortlisted in stage-1 shall be called for final interviews which will be held offline on the campus.

The mode of selection might vary from one academic division to another academic division. Also, it may vary from one programme to the other programme within the same academic division.

The mode of selection for a particular programme and discipline will be announced along with the schedule of selections.

9. For PhD programme, the shortlisting and the selection may be done specialization wise by the respective academic division.

10. Institute Assistantship Test for MTech Level Applicants of PhD programme (IATMLA):

- There is a provision for availing Institute Assistantship for a PhD student **without** GATE/CEED but having the qualification of **MTech/MDes/MS(R) or equivalent**.
- The academic divisions can opt for conducting IATMLA irrespective of the number of applications. Amongst others, if the number of eligible applicants is more than 5 times the number of advertised seats, then IATMLA can be optional for the concerned academic division.
- If an applicant is shortlisted in an academic division conducting IATMLA, he/she may be allowed to appear in a Written Test on a prescribed syllabus. The candidates qualified in the Written Test will be considered for the selection process.
- **Pre-requisite:** Application for PhD programme must be under “Regular” category.
- **Qualification:** MTech/MDes/MS(R) or equivalent who have NOT qualified GATE/CEED.
[Clarification-1: This test is not required for those with MTech/MDes/MS(R) or equivalent who have qualified GATE/CEED at some point of time.]
[Clarification-2: This test is not applicable to the candidates with BTech/MSc/MA/MCA/MBA qualification. They require valid GATE score]
- **Written Test Modalities:**
Mode: Offline test conducted at IIT Guwahati campus (typically, one or two days before the schedule of selections)
Duration: 2 to 3 Hours (to be decided by the respective academic division)
Qualifying Criteria: (i) 40% for GEN or GEN-EWS (ii) 36% for OBC-NCL (iii) 26% for SC/ST/PwD

- For the Session July 2025, the following academic divisions will conduct IATMLA irrespective of the number of applications: Dept. of CSE, Dept. of EEE, Dept. of ME, Dept. of Civil Engg., Dept. of Chemical Engg., School of DS&AI, School of Energy Sci & Engg., Centre for the Environment, Centre for Linguistic Sci & Tech., Centre for Intelligent Cyber Physical Systems, Centre for Disaster Management & Research, Centre for Sustainable Polymers, and Centre for Sustainable Water Research. The IATMLA is optional for other academic divisions.

11. Applicants have to visit this website and websites of respective academic divisions regularly for information regarding shortlisting and selection of candidates. No personalized information can be expected in this regard. IIT Guwahati will not be responsible for delayed response from the applicants.

12. The results of shortlisting and selection shall be announced on the Application Portal. The applicants may login to the portal and check the results.

7. Results and Acceptance of Seats

1. The candidates can check the updates on shortlisting/selections on the Application Portal. The applicants may login to the portal and check the updates from time to time.

2. The candidates who have participated in the selection process can check the status of the results on their login to the application portal. The result information includes whether the candidate is Qualified or Not. If qualified, whether a seat is offered or in wait-list. If wait-listed, the current wait-list number for OPEN seat as well as reserved category seat, if any.

3. The candidates who were offered seats have to accept the seats by making the payment of requisite fee before the last date mentioned there. Otherwise, the seats will be offered to those next in the waiting list.
4. The selection is provisional, subject to production of all the relevant documents at the time of admission.
5. The selection may be cancelled at any point if the candidature is found to be against the ordinances, rules and regulations of the Institute.
6. Selected candidates whose qualifying degree results are awaited shall have to produce their original Pass Certificates and Mark Sheets as per the timelines decided by the Academic Affairs Section.
7. After accepting the offered seat by paying the requisite fee, if a candidate wants to withdraw, he/she can express the same on the application portal latest by 15 July 2025 .
8. If the withdrawal request is received by 15 July 2025 , a sum of Rs. 1,000/- only shall be deducted from the fee deposited. In case of late requests, only refundable portion of the fee deposited shall be returned. Applicable refund amount shall be sent from IIT Guwahati in October 2025 .
9. For dates of registration and start of classes, please see the important dates column.
10. For notification regarding candidates selected for admission, admission offer letter, etc., IIT Guwahati will NOT send any hard copy letter to the candidates by post.
