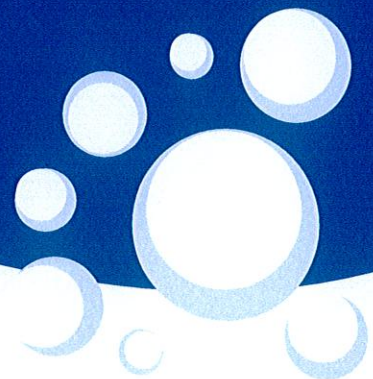

## Bengaluru Monthly Meet-up 2 (#g2g): Dec 17, 2017



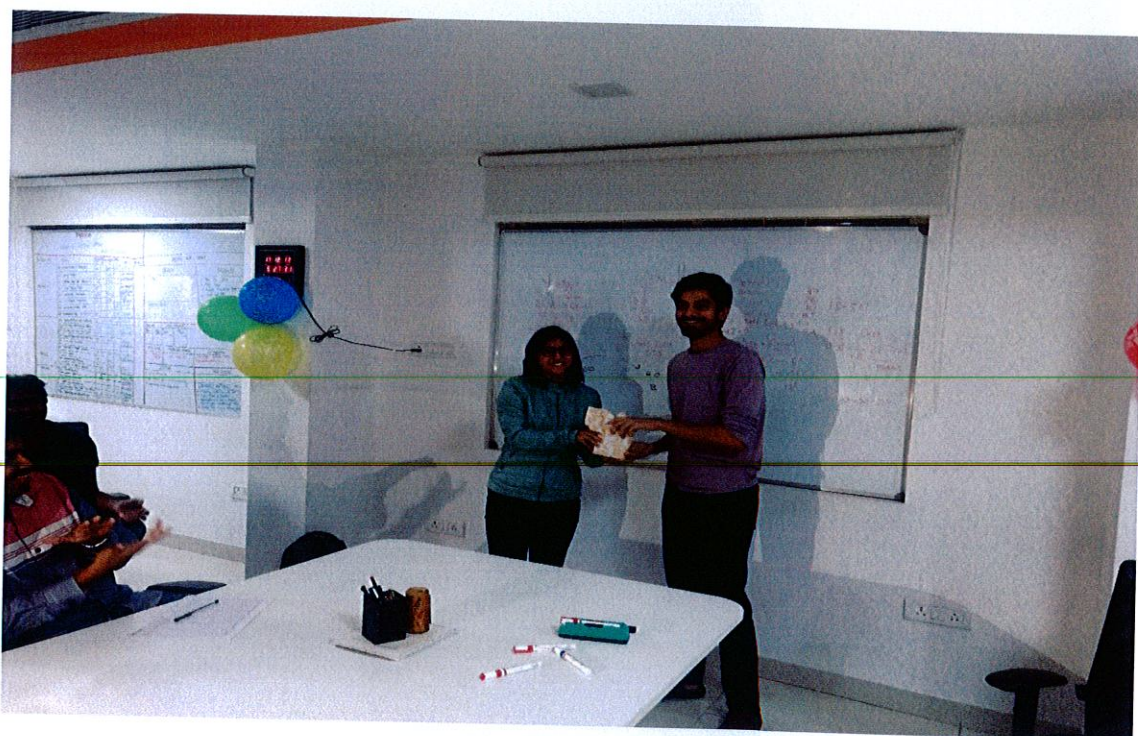

The alumni enjoyed a pleasant evening, networking with speakers and fellow alumni, with tea and snacks.

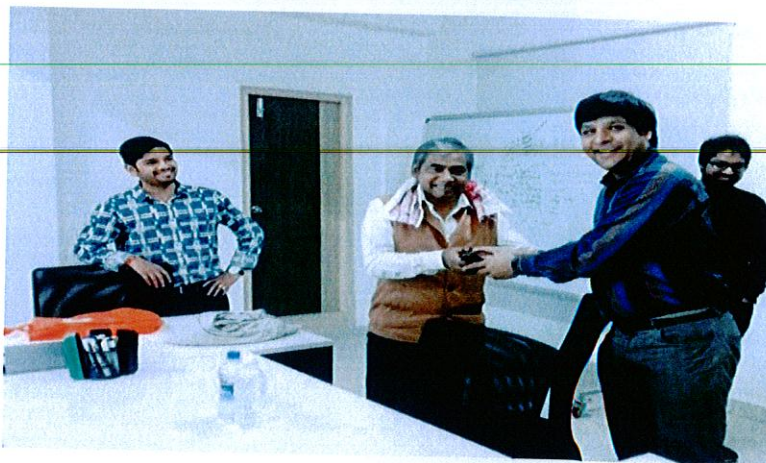


## Alumni Meet-up with Professor Sanjay Kumar Bose (Bengaluru): Dec 27, 2017

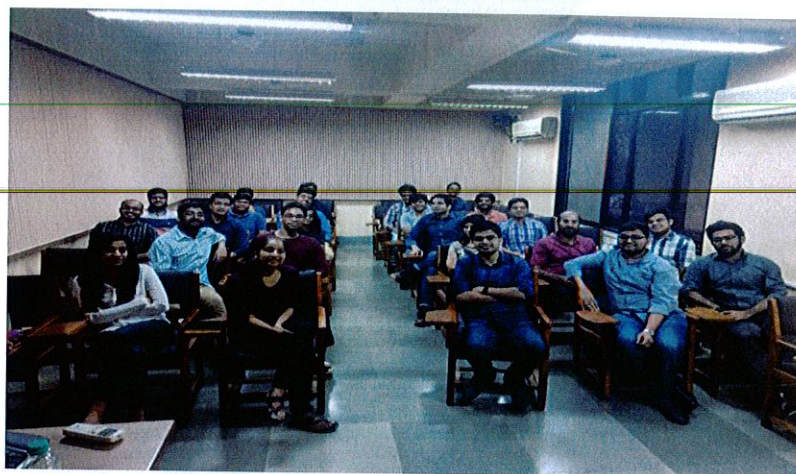
### **Mumbai Regular Meet-up: Jan 7, 2018**

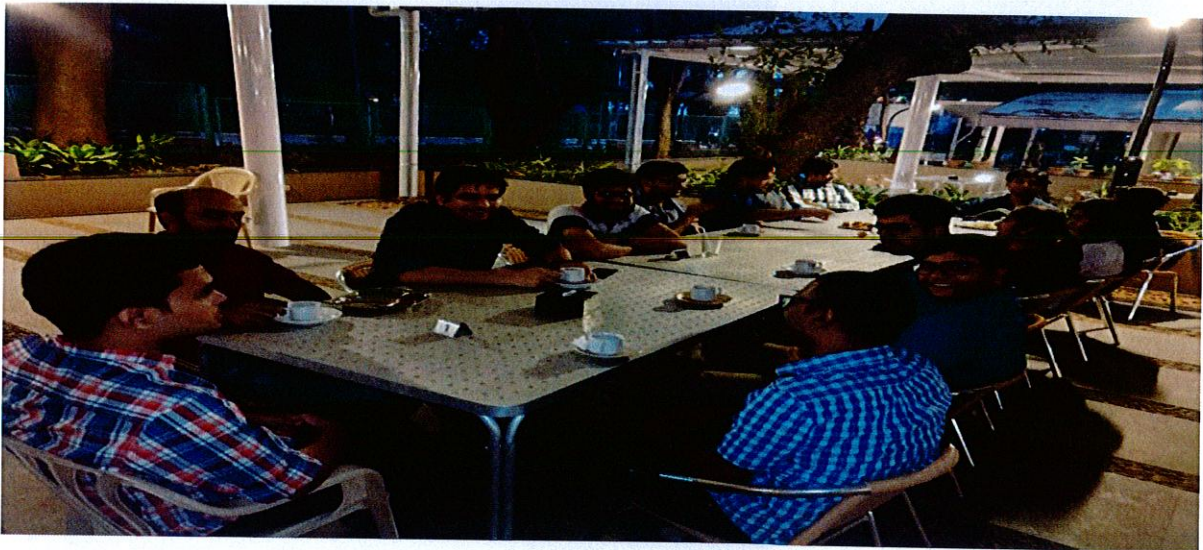
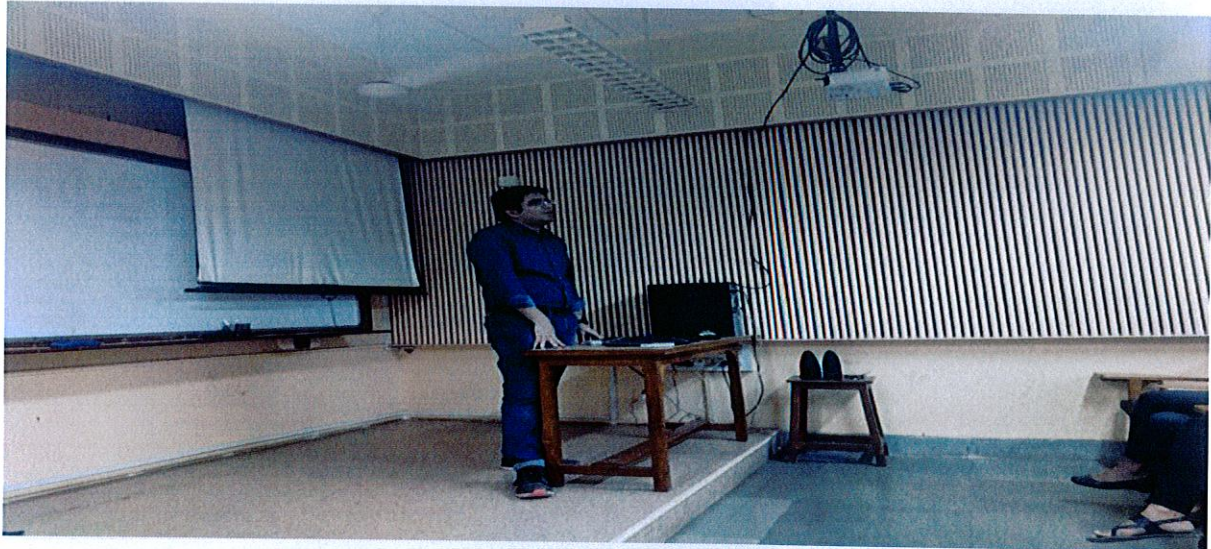
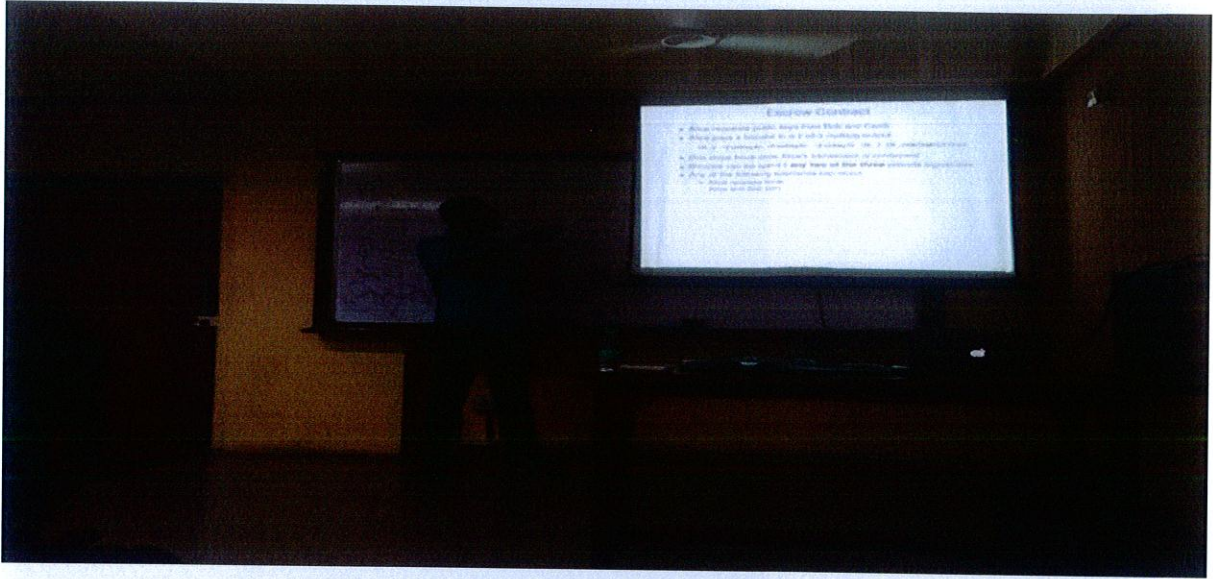

### Druva Inc. – co-founded by our alumnus Jaspreet Singh

Druva Inc. a company co-founded by our alumnus Jaspreet Singh, B.Tech (CSE), Class of 2004 is among the most successful start-ups of IIT Guwahati. The latest round of funding brought the total amount raised by Druva close to \$200 million. One observer has described the company as on track to be the first SaaS 'unicorn' (that is, valued at \$1 billion or more) to come out of India, as Druva was originally founded in Pune before relocating to sunny Sunnyvale.
