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HIGHLIGHTS OF INTERNSHIP SEASON 2025-26

The Internship Season 2025—26 saw participation from 80 companies, resulting in 85 internship offers before 1 August 2025. An overall internship percentage of 42% was achieved, with strong branch-wise performance reflecting a diverse range of opportunities across the campus

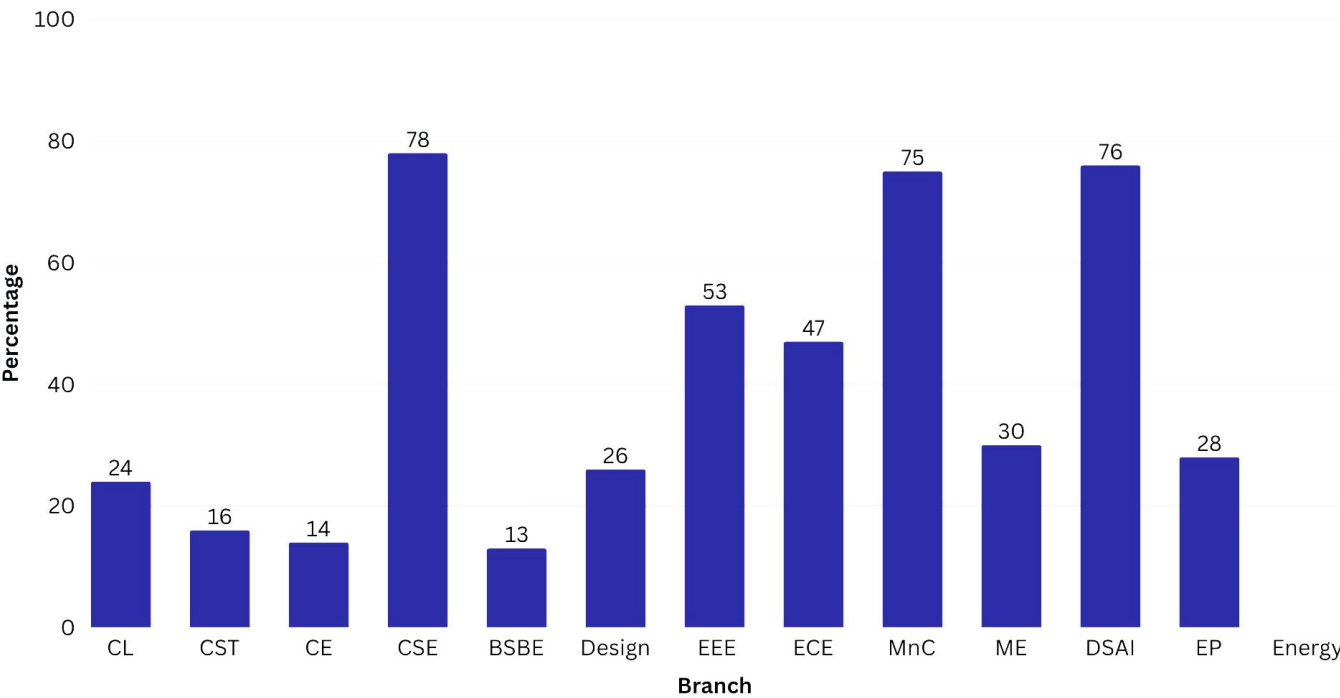

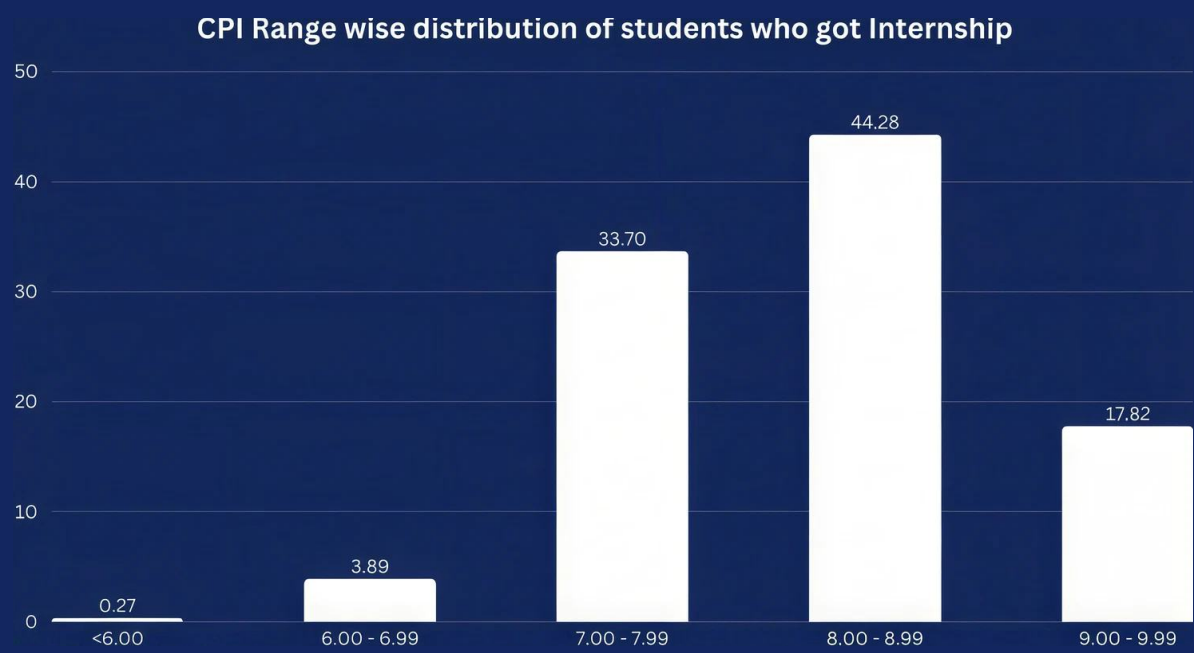

Percentage of students got internship v/s Branch

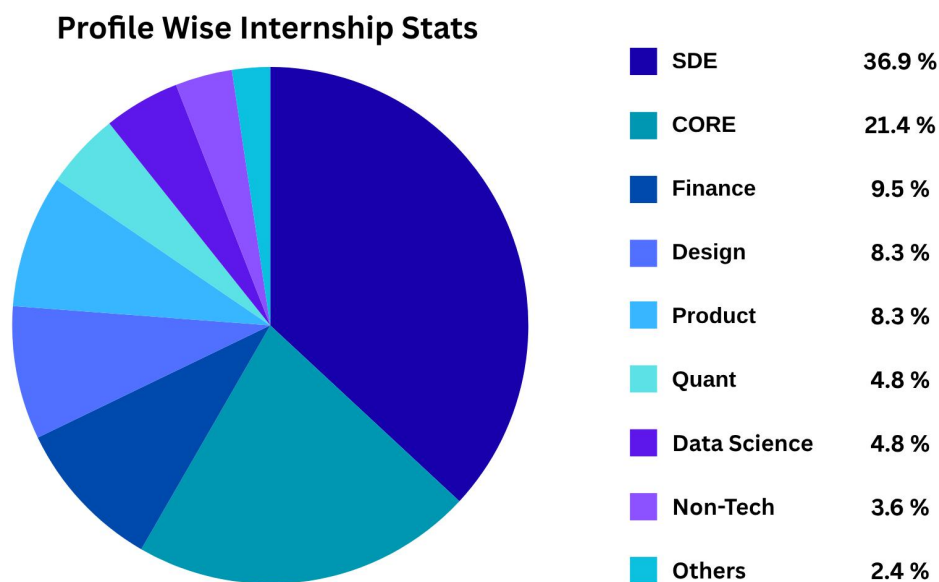


HIGHLIGHTS OF INTERNSHIP SEASON 2025-26

Among the students who secured internships, the largest share (44.28%) had a CPI between 8.00 and 8.99, followed by 33.70% in the 7.00—7.99 range. Together, these two groups account for nearly 78% of all internship recipients.



Internship opportunities were dominated by SDE and Core Engineering roles, while Finance, Design, Product, Quant, and Data Science collectively contributed to a diverse range of career opportunities across industries.



HIGHLIGHTS OF PLACEMENT SEASON 2025-26

In the placement session 2025-26 (started from 1st December), a total of around 280 companies from various sectors participated in the recruitment process. The total number of students registered for campus placement in the academic year 2025-26 is 1684, out of which 1004 students have been placed.

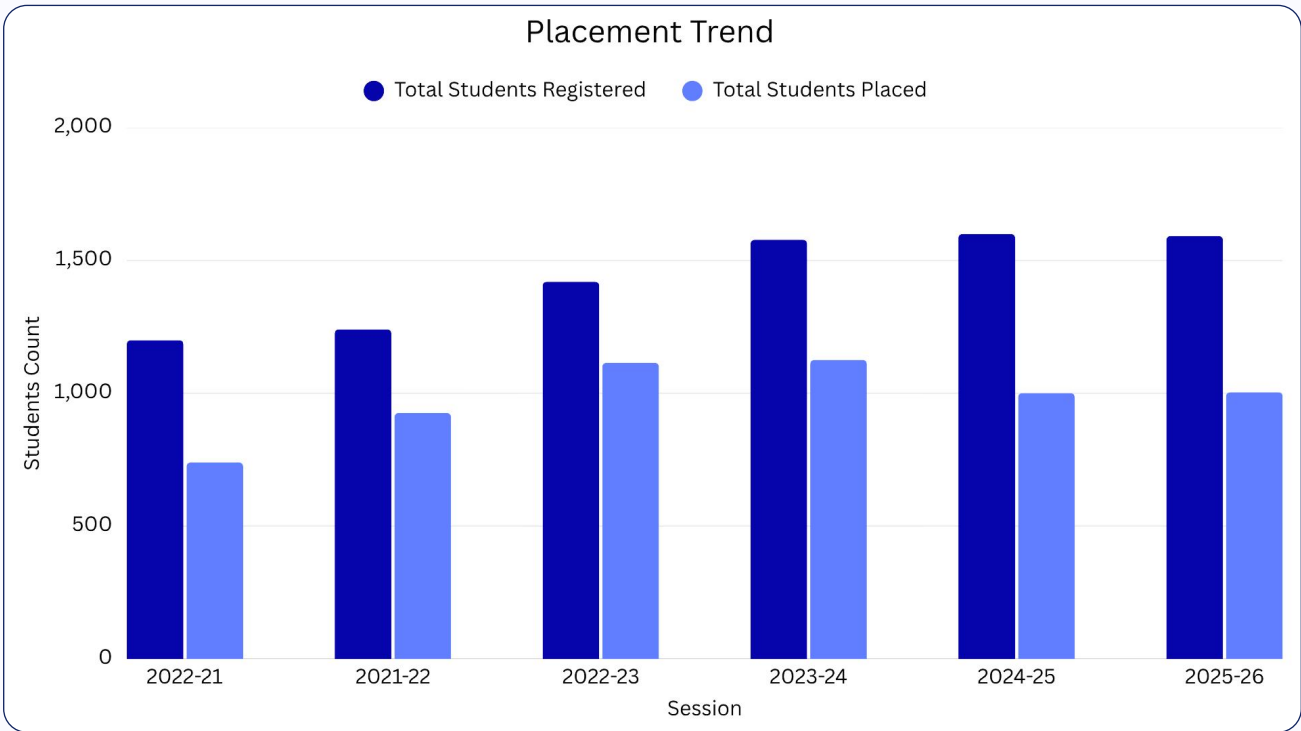

For this academic year, the percentage of registered male students placed was 59.39% while the registered female students placed was 60.43%.

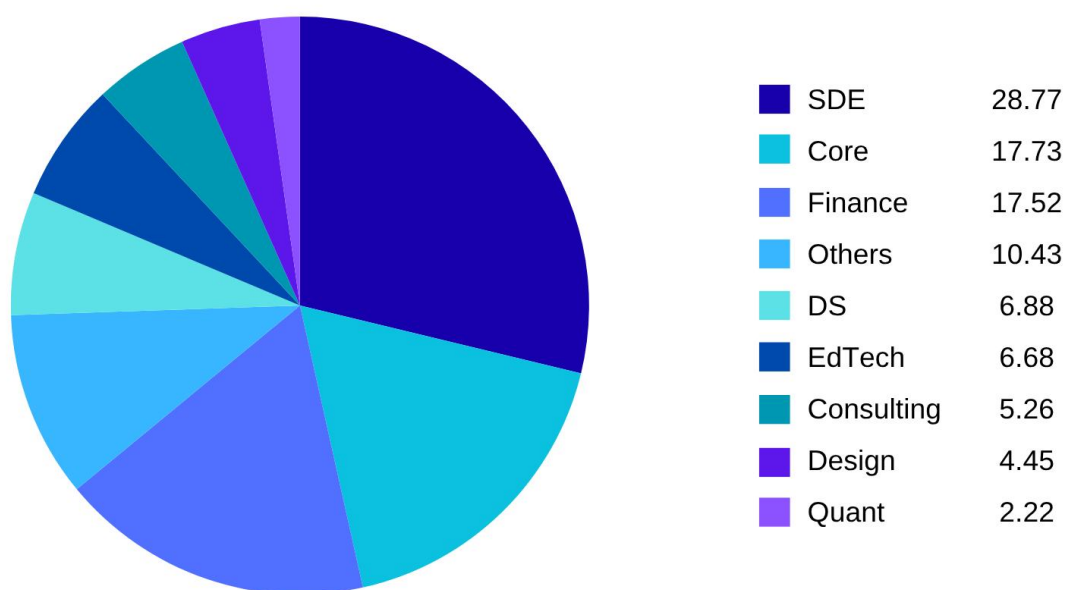

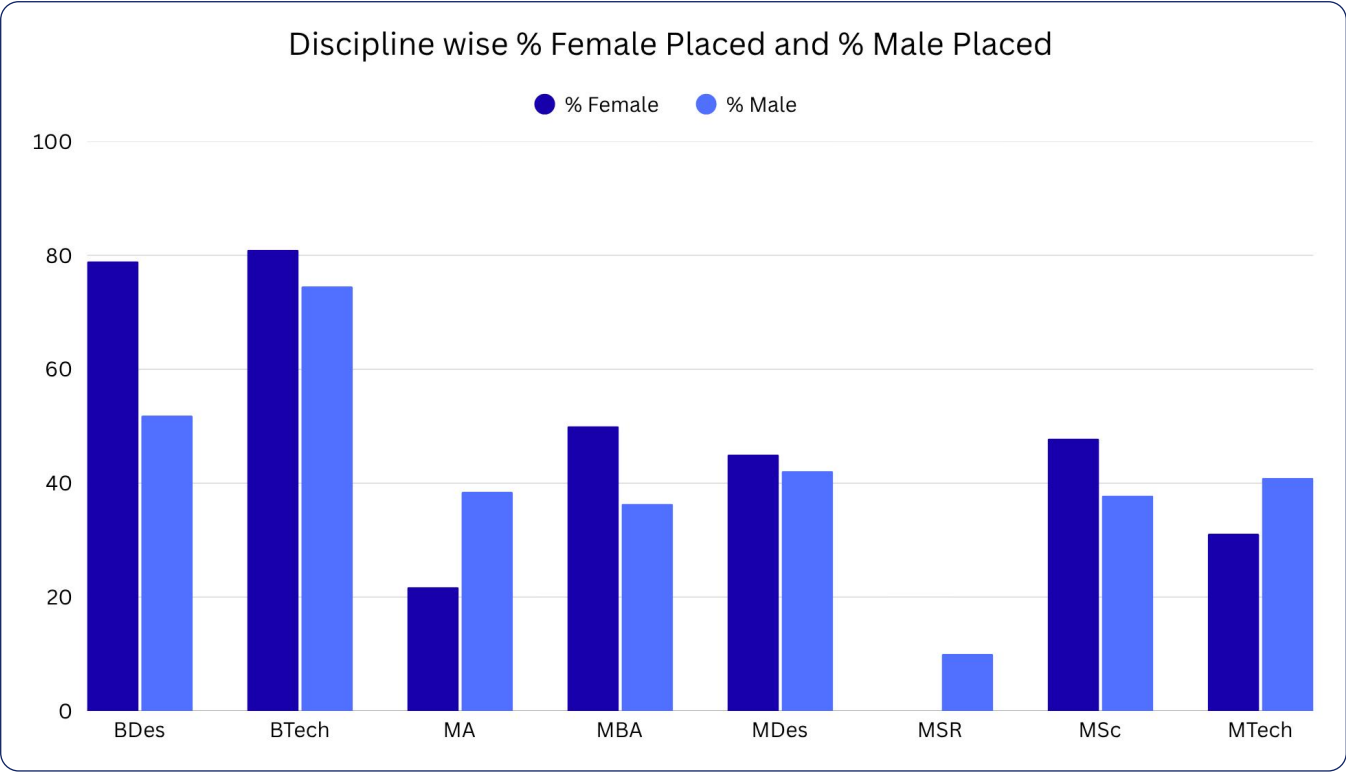
Profile wise Placement Distribution



OVERALL DISCIPLINE-WISE STUDENT PLACEMENT DATA

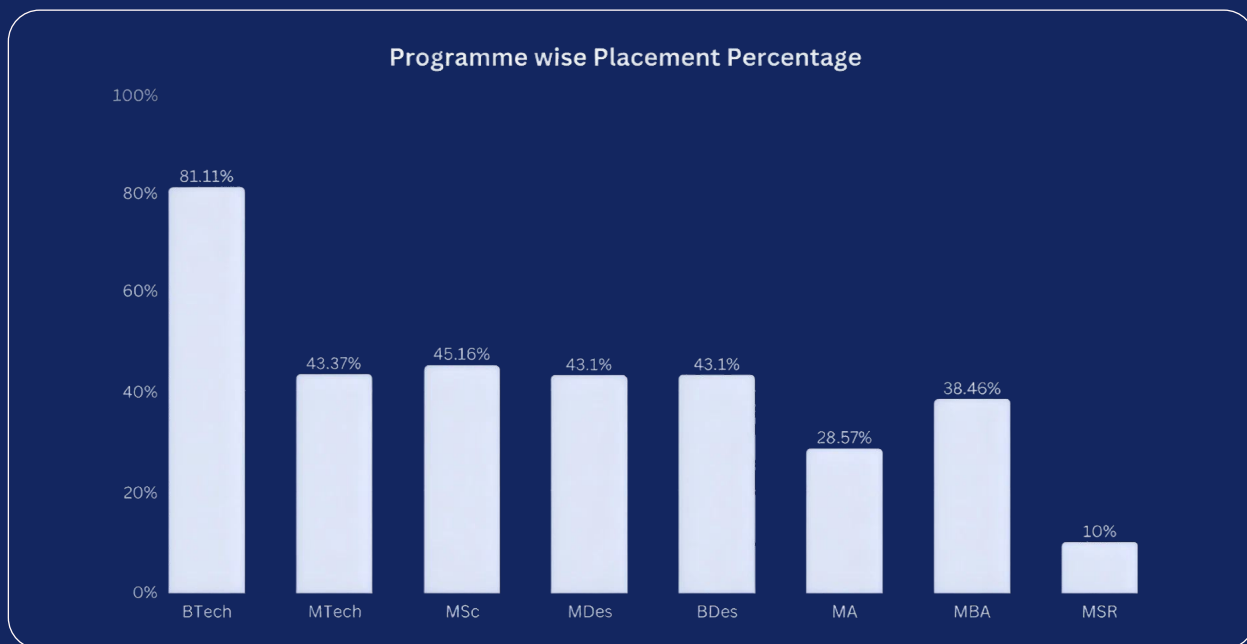

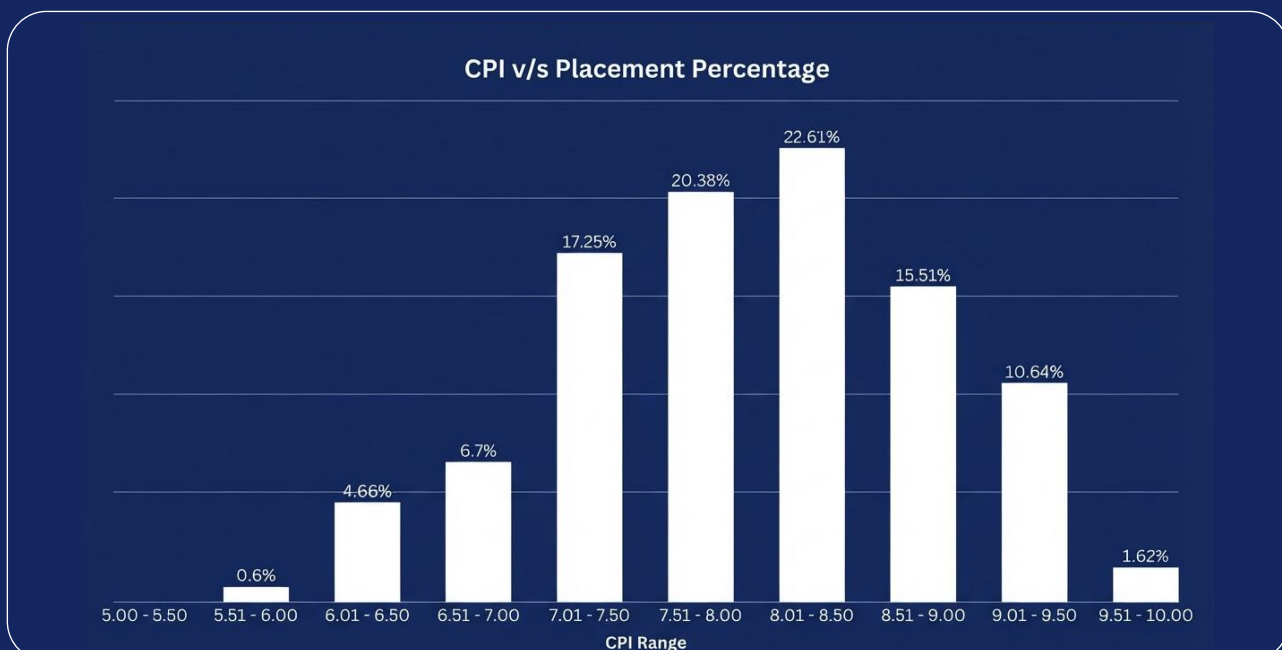
PROGRAMME WISE PLACEMENT PERCENTAGE

B.Tech recorded the highest placement percentage (81.11%), followed by B.Des (43.10%) and M.Des (43.10%). Programme-wise placement percentages varied across disciplines.



CPI vs PLACEMENT PERCENTAGE

The majority of the placed students had a CPI in the range of 7.5 to 8.5. 162 of the placed students had their CPI in the range of 9.5 to 10.



UG (BDes and BTech) PLACEMENT DATA

The disciplines of Computer Science and Engineering, Mathematics and Computing, and Data Science and Artificial Intelligence recorded the highest placement percentages of 87-91% among all the undergraduate programmes.

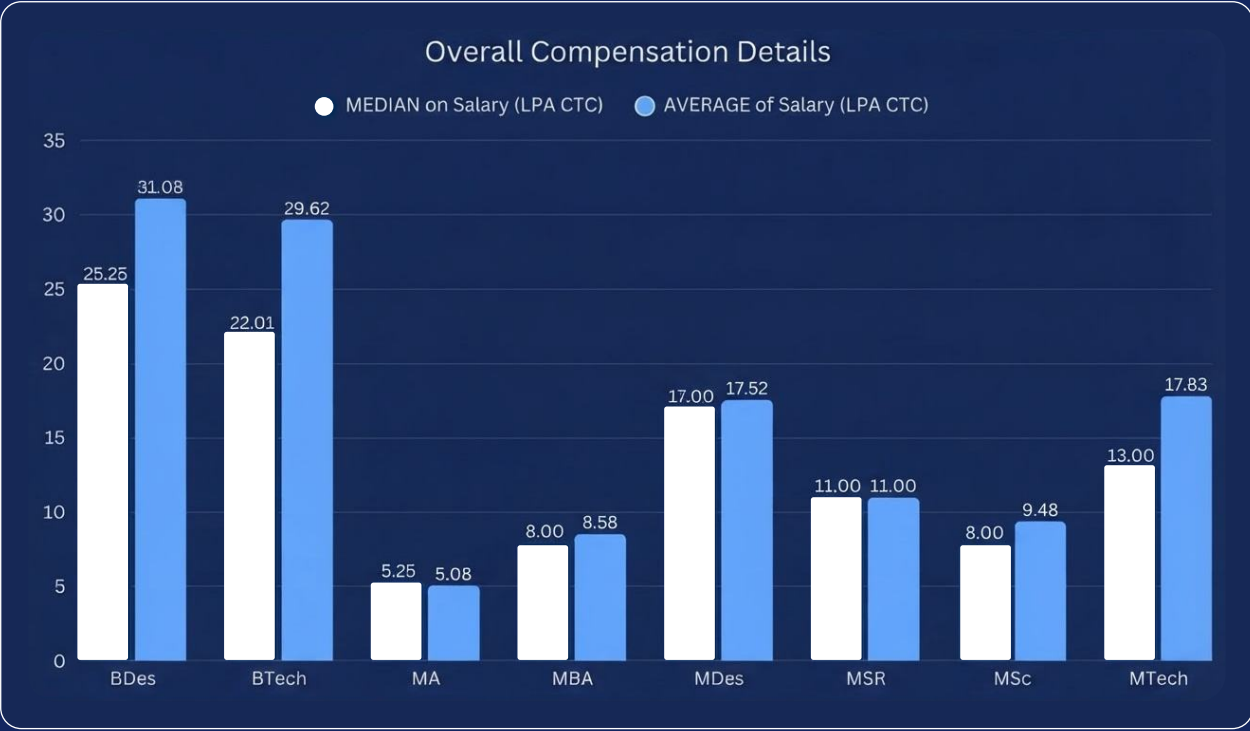

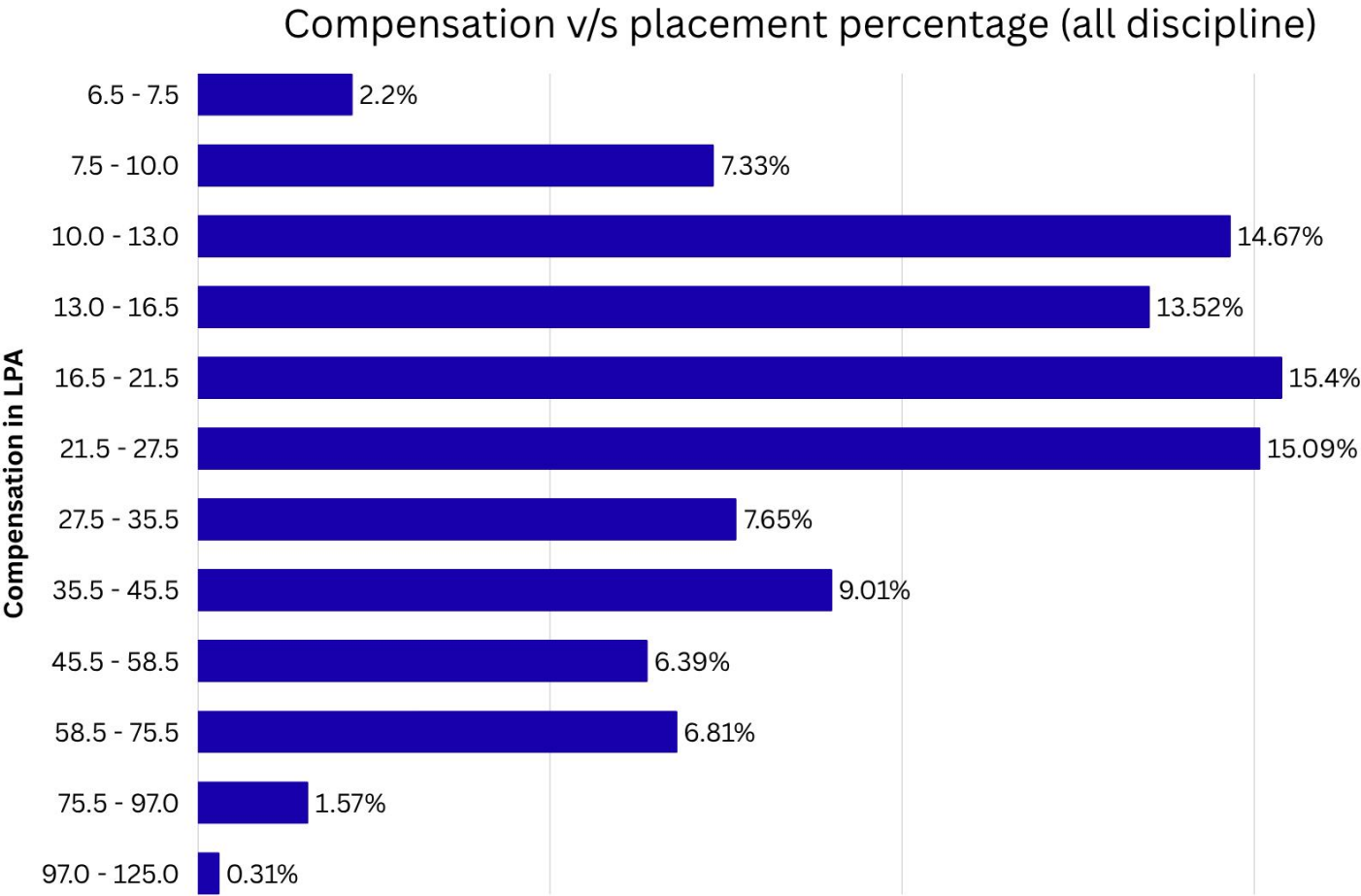

COMPENSATION vs PLACEMENT PERCENTAGE

The compensation distribution reflects a balanced placement outcome across a wide range of salary brackets. The 16.5—21.5 LPA range records the highest placement share at 15.40%, closely followed by the 21.5—27.5 LPA (15.09%) and 10—13 LPA (14.67%) brackets. Together, the 10—27.5 LPA range accounts for nearly 59% of all placements, highlighting a strong concentration of offers in the mid-to-high compensation segments while also showcasing opportunities across both lower and premium salary ranges.
