## About the Conference

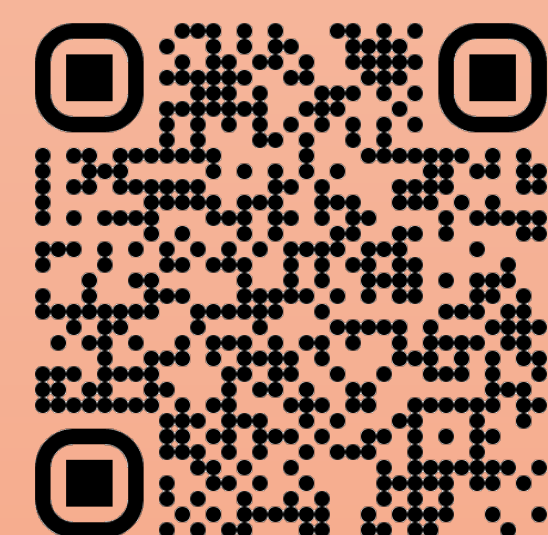
