About Pandit Hemchandra Goswami

Pandit Hemchandra Goswami (1872–1928) made immense contribution to Assamese language, literature, history and society. He was elected the fourth president of Asom Sahitya Sabha in 1920. He established that Assamese is not a dialect of any language but derived from Sanskrit. First Assamese dictionary Hemkosh was published by Pandit Goswami in 1900. He also edited Katha Bhagawat and Katha Gita by Bhattadev, which are considered important texts of Vaishnavite tradition.
