Navigating Public Spaces: An Ethnographic Study of Gendered Mobility on DTC Buses in Delhi

Masters' Dissertation under the guidance of Dr. Rituparna Patgiri, Assistant Professor of Sociology at the Department of Humanities and Social Sciences, IIT Guwahati. This dissertation investigates how women experience public spaces in Delhi, focusing on their access to and use of Delhi Transport Corporation (DTC) buses. Through ethnographic research, it examines the challenges women face in terms of mobility and safety on public buses, explores the impact of policies like free bus travel for women, and compares the DTC bus system with the Delhi Metro.
